What does organization do?

*. Provide Basic & skill based Education for children up to 12 yrs and for domestic female workers.

*. Give awareness on Health issues and personal hygiene to women.

*. Conduct capacity building programs on issues based on human rights for women and Children.

*. Conduct trainings: Sunday school teachers training; Adult literacy teachers training; Skill development trainings;

*. To publish booklets and pamphlets on Spiritual growth and Health issues.

Activities 2009

- A. Conception of TSM, Documentation and selection of Board Members in October 2008.
- B. January 18, 2009 TSM launched its first activity "Talent Hunt" a singing competition for Children at Salvation Army Church- Lahore. 30 Children participated from eight indigenous Churches. Altogether there were 100 Sunday school teachers, parents and children.



C. One day Bible teaching Seminar was conducted on July 2009 at Salvation Army Community hall, Lahore. Rev. Prof. Christopher Hawk and Rev. Shaphan Sabir led the Bible Studies. Miss. Rebecca Khan, Miss. Uzma Ashiq, Mr. Asher Moon Bhatti along with 30 participants were present in this seminar representing 12 Christian organizations.



- D. Family seminar "Persecutions and Christian Witness" was conducted at local Brethren Church Cavalry ground Lahore Cantt on September 28, 2009. Mr. Tony William from OTS led seminar and 80 people were blessed. Miss. Rebecca Khan (President) TSM and Mr. Asher Moon Bhatti (treasurer) were present at this event.
- E. Youth seminar at Sadhu Sundar Singh Fellowship, Jalo Pind on November 6, 2009. Asher Ashiq and Rebecca Khan conducted sessions on "Christian Witness and the role of youth".
- F. November 12th, 2009 a youth program was arranged at Hoor Camp- Hyderabad with the cooperation of Rev. Saleem Iqbal Vicar St. Philips Church Hyderabad and youth leader Arif Gill. 30 active youth leaders were blessed from this seminar "Christian witness and persecutions".
- G. X-MAS Celebration with local Sunday school Children on December 12, 2009 at Salvation Army Church- Lahore. At this occasion 120 Children were involved and praised the Lord joyfully by carol singing.





Activities 2010:

February 21, 2010, (one day) on "importance of Christian Education for our Children" was arranged by TSM at Border line area (village). 25 participants were present to be benefitted from this Seminar. It was led by Miss. Rebecca Khan and Fr. Sharif Sardar.



A. **Basic Education Program 'AlKhair Schools'** located at rural areas (Khambianwala and Moranawala) in district Sheikhupura. This Program is conceived and funded by Alkhair Trust.

In October 2010 TSM Pakistan has takenover the basic Education Program and now these schools are serving community under the management of TSM Pakistan. It is a great privilege for us to work with brick klin community at rural site.



Activities 2011

We are, as team also struggling to skill the unskilled women in these areas through sewing centers which were established in **April 2011** at Moranwala and Naseerabad and with the Support of RCCM Pakistan. Presently 120 women are benefiting from this project in six months course. Yearly 240 women will be able to earn respectfully by the skills they got from these centers.

There is a need for spiritual growth and health awareness as people are illiterate and unaware.



B. One day school teachers refresher course

TSM Pakistan has conducted one day basic Education Teachers Refresher course at Lahore. As per our policy twice a year we will provide training to our teachers after need assessment. Mr. Zafar Ismail trustee of Al-Khair Trust funded this training.

Altogether there were 13 teachers. 4-Teachers belonged to Al-khair School, AL-Khair School System serving brick klin communities. Other 9 participants who attended this refresher course were from one of the FCC-Basti school who are serving to domestic workers Children. They offered us their premises for training. The responses of teachers were very good and effective.

Venue & Date

Training was held at Local School St. Albert School (Primary) Lahore on Thursday

September 1, 2011.

Training Purpose

The purpose of training was "to equip and introduce teachers' with new teaching methods for the nourishment of mind and body of students".

Training components

- a. Lesson planning
- b. Assessment of Students (Remarked and mark based)
- c. Preparation of worksheets for classes I & II
- d. Physical Education "Kids Athletics"

Activities of 2012

A. One day Women seminar on September 14, 2012 at Tarikhni village on "**The role of women in family relationships**" district Pakpattan. 80 women participated and this seminar is sponsored by Rev. Shahbaz Pastor in ARP Church Arifwala District Pakpattan.





B. One day Youth seminar on November 3, 2012 at Islamabad on **"Our Christian Identity"** at the present scenario when presecutions are going on in an Islamic state. Seminary was sponsor by Doer Trust Islamabad.



C. Health Awareness seminar on **"T.B health awareness"** held at Johar Town Basti of Domestic workers on November 16, 2012.

There were 70 youth and women participated in this T.B health awareness compaign. Mr. Zafar Daniel (TSM), Sadia and Nosherwan (Mercy corp activists) conducted this seminar in collaboration with TSM and awareness compaign sponsorsed by Mercy Corp Lahore.



D. Dignity of children

One day awareness raising session on "Dignity of Children" conducted in Joshua Generation School, Asif town Lahore on November 28, 2012. 80 Children attended this session and blessed.
