It was then that God's peace replaced my worries.

During the first few years, we faced many challenges and struggles. However God's guidance, provision, strength, and support remained visible to us through our generous and supportive church friends. Ultimately my wife and I got good jobs in our professions, and our sons settled well into their studies.

Even in chaotic situations, as we keep on trusting God we can feel God's hand on us — leading, guiding, encouraging, providing for, and protecting us.

Georgine asked me to update you on Pastor Shah's and his Family's situation but first I want to thank you for your Love, Prayers and Support for Pastor Shah and his Ministry, during this transitional time of him and family, living with his brother in law. Most of you know his family was evicted (thrown out) quite unexpectedly from their rental apartment by the government police, while Pastor Shah was away on a mission trip. I can send you a video clip of the eviction if you email me, faithworx365@gmail.com

This eviction was possibly due to persecution being inflicted on leaders of religions other than unofficial state religion, who are perceived as a threat. Due to U.S. unrest, it makes one wonder if we are next. The most interesting thing I notice in the clip is a bold but simple wooden cross hanging on the exterior wall adjoining the balcony in full view of those who pass by, bravely showing his home has a place of love and refuge for all, Pastor Shah indicates landlords are currently reluctant to rent to people who are of a religious affiliation other than major religion, especially a leader, for fear of retribution. And even if he can move forward with an apartment, what would prevent this from happening again?

It seems the safest and most secure method of housing for him and family is home ownership. Georgine, Terry, and I have conversed with Pastor Shah in length regarding this concept as it unfolds, and I am happy to say the update Georgine was referring to me providing, is very good news! Pastor Shah has identified a small flat which evidently is similar to his old rental flat for sale for what Georgine and I think is below market price and is move in ready! Based on this, Pastor Shah has secured an option on the home for a brief period. Also good news the monthly payments are similar to amount he was having to pay for rent so there is no additional ongoing expense. The home costs \$42,857. Pastor Shah has found a bank who will finance the home if a \$6428 down payment is made; again the monthly payment would approach \$300 per month similar to his previous monthly rent. The only additional charge required to move in is a \$108 electrical security deposit. Therefore total upfront costs equals \$6536.

The Upper Room Family has done so much for Pastor Shah's ministry this year, however the HOLY SPIRIT has shown us several times when confronted with the dilemma of whether to present Pastor Shah's case to Our Upper Room Family "to either lead, follow, or get out of the way"! So... we are providing the details and "getting out of the way"! Please contact me or Georgine if you have questions.

If so led please Pray for Pastor Shah and his Family. If further led to financially support, there are several ways to give besides wiring Pastor Shah direct. If you feel led to wire direct, please contact me at faithworx365@gmail.com and I will provide wiring instructions.

However apparently many outlets now have a scam alert form to fill out as standard protocol for all wire transfers. I was informed about this from a UR Faithful who attempted but was denied because apparently her answers did not fit the approval criteria. Please notify if you successfully send money this way, either by text, phone (# appears below) or email, and I will pick up in a timely manner. and add to the tally.
- 3. I also have set up a PO Box for Pastor Shah to receive checks and cash.. Since this is a timely campaign it would be great to send via a form of Priority Mail, although very happy to receive via regular mail. I do not wait for checks to clear but wire funds immediately upon receipt, including them in next batch. 
